

Four Mandatory Steps to Recertification for 2018-2019

Step 1 ON-LINE:

When you register you will be enrolled in the on-line recertification modules. It's called **0404eAFAre-certWhitby2018** and takes 40 minutes to complete in one sitting. Look for login credentials to come by email from elarning@skipatrol.on.ca. If you cannot complete this at home contact Rob Carson carsoncsp1@gmail.com to arrange to complete it at a training centre.

Step 2 TRAINING CENTRE:

Attend the Training Record session you chose during registration. The training record must be completed before any candidate will be allowed to challenge the diagnostic.

Step 3 ON-LINE:

Your registration will enroll you in the **on-line** National Written Exam. Due to security, the eExam login is more complex. Instructions will come from the National eExam coordinator about two weeks after you register. It is suggested that you study for and complete the written as a warm up for the diagnostic exam. Legacy paper exams will still be available on request.

Step 4 TRAINING CENTRE:

Attend the Diagnostic Exam session you chose during registration.

ON-LINE RESOURCES:

New first aid training videos. These cover most of the topics on the training record. The path is NDS> Zone/Division/National Shared files> National Files> Training and development (Education)> First Aid Videos> FA skills.
